

# Teen Digital Photo Contest Rules 2020



Theme: **Hometown Pride- brag about your hometown with a digital photograph.**

1. All contest participants must be youth in 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades who are served by the Public Library of Enid and Garfield County.
2. Entries must be digital photographs.
3. Entries must not include identifiable people.
4. Entries can be emailed to [tray@enid.org](mailto:tray@enid.org) or [publiclibrary@enid.org](mailto:publiclibrary@enid.org). Entries can also be submitted on external storage devices directly to the teen librarian in the library.
5. Entries must be the original work by the participant.
6. Entries must be submitted by 4PM on September 24, 2020.
7. Each entry must include the following:
  - a. Name (first and last) and age of the photographer
  - b. Contact information for the participant or parent (telephone or email)
  - c. Title of the photograph
    - i. The title of the photograph must not include the photographer's name
  - d. Date and location of the photograph
  - e. Type of camera (iPhone 11, CoolPix, etc.)
8. Each participant may submit up to 2 photographs.
9. Photographs will be on display in the teen section of the library for voting during the month of October.
10. Photographs will be displayed without information identifying the photographer.
11. Winners will be chosen in 3 categories: Overall Winner, Staff Choice, and People's Choice.
12. Winners will be announced on October 28<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 PM.
13. Prizes: (reproduction sizes may be reduced dependent upon available pixels of original submission)
  - a. Overall Winner – 11 x 14 canvas reproduction of winning photograph
  - b. Staff Choice & People's Choice – Framed 11 x 14 reproduction of winning photograph
  - c. All participants will receive an 8 x 10 print of their photograph.
  - d. Additional prizes may be added.
14. By submitting your photograph you are granting publishing and reproduction rights to the City of Enid and the Public Library of Enid and Garfield.
