





Who are the Friends?

The Friends of the Library of Enid, Oklahoma are a group of citizens who are committed to making the library *better*. They do this by volunteering, sponsoring events, workshops and programs. They support the library financially with donations, purchases for the library, and advocating for funding. They also manage the bi-annual Friends of the Library book sale, they plan special events and fundraising events.

The Friends are simply everyday citizens who are also patrons of the library that want to help.

Does this sound like you? Are you a patron of the library who is interested in volunteering in our pollinator garden? Maybe you have always seen yourself as something of a librarian—the book sale might be perfect for you! Perhaps you have an idea we haven't thought of yet?

HOW TO HELP THE FRIENDS

The Friends are looking for help in many ways. The first thing that you can do is JOIN! An individual membership is \$10 per year, and a business membership is \$200 per year.

Other ways to help Friends after joining, include volunteering. There are TONS of volunteer opportunities with Friends, including the bi-annual book sale, serving on a Friends committee, or planning special Friends events.

Maybe you have lots of contacts in town, and you want to bring them onboard with you to Friends. This is a great thing. Friends can ALWAYS use more help.

We are ALWAYS looking for people of varied talents and backgrounds. We need people who have all kinds of abilities so that we can do all kinds of things for the library.

WHAT THE FRIENDS CAN DO

Friends is an organization known for donations to the library. Sometimes those donations are monetary for purchases that the library needs, like giant Legos, or a light block in the Children's Dept. Friends has also donated the fees to send our Librarians to National conferences.



BECOMING A FRIEND

Becoming a Friend is so easy. Applications are available all over town! Just about anywhere that books are available, so is an application.

Applications for you (and for a friend! Hint, hint) are available at the Public Library of Enid and Garfield County, Putnam 6 Bookstore, Felt Bird and Park Ave. Thrift Store.

Once you have filled out your application, bring it and your yearly application fee (\$10 per individual, \$200 per business) to the Library and your application will be processed at the next Friends of the Library meeting.

Friends meet every second Monday of the month in the Local History Room of the Public Library—you are welcome to come as soon as you have paid your yearly dues!

There is always something to do, it might be time to volunteer for the book sale, work in the pollinator garden, or to plan a special Friends of the Library Event for the Public Library.
