



Register and track your family's summer reading through the Beanstack App!!

How to Register

Using a mobile device? Download the App!

- Launch the app and tap Let's Go! When asked how you will participate, click At My Library.
- On the next screen, go to the bottom and type Enid in the Find a Site search section.
- The Enid Public Library will be the only result from your search.
 Click on it.
- You will be taken to the Sign In page. Click on Sign Up! at the bottom of the page to create your new account with a username and password.
- Click **No** since you haven't used Beanstack before.
- Follow the prompts to create your parent account (your child will be entered next). If you want to participate in challenges for adults, fill out your reader profile.
- Tap Add a Reader and follow the prompts by entering your child's information.
- When the screen says Challenges, you will see all of the reading challenges currently available for your child through the Enid Public Library. Tap Register under the Adventure Begins at Your Library banner, then tap Register on the pop-up and tap Continue at the bottom right.
- If you need to add a second child, tap Add Another Reader and repeat the steps from above. Otherwise, tap I'm done adding readers.



To log reading time without recording titles:

- Tap the plus at the bottom-center of the screen and tap **Reading**.
- Tap the circle to log Reading.
- Tap on Log Without a Title.
- Enter the number of minutes your child spent reading, then click
 Done.

To log reading time AND to record titles:

- Tap the plus at the bottom-center of the screen and tap **Reading**.
- Enter the title of the book your child is reading or scan the ISBN code of the book.
- Select the correct book and then click Save. You will then have a
 choice to Start Timer, Log Reading or Quick Complete. Choose
 Log Reading and enter the number of minutes read, then click
 Done.

Seasonal reading challenges are completed by reading a certain number of minutes. Prizes or books are earned by children for every three hours of reading completed and recorded on Beanstack.

The Children's Department also offers reading challenges for various Reader's Choice Awards: the Oklahoma Sequoyah Award, the Donna Norvell Award, the Triple Crown Awards, and the Redbud Award. These challenges are completed by reading a certain number of books on each award's Master List and by logging the titles of the books read. Children who read at least three books on a reader's choice award reading challenge will be invited to a voting party at the library in March or April of 2025; children will vote for their favorite book and votes will be submitted to the official voting websites for each award.
